Montana

- 92.2% of children were served in licensed care
- 5.9% of children were cared for by relatives
- Children under 1 year of age were in child care an average of 116 hours per month
- School-age children (ages 6 and older) constitute 26.2% of all children served
- White children accounted for 79.9% of all children served
